This award-winning music video was mainly filmed at Oheka Castle, the second largest home in the U.S. Built in for financier and philanthropist Otto Hermann Kahn, the 1919 Gold Coast estate was designed by Delano & Aldrich with gardens of the Olmsted Brothers (sons of Frederick Law Olmsted of Central Park fame). Oheka is now a wedding and event venue (and hotel) where celebrities like Kevin Jonas (who is also on this list) have married. If we ever get a chance to visit Oheka, we promise not to throw the décor into, stick the perfectly painted portraits in ruin, and have a messy, mascara-devastating breakdown in front of a marble mantle. WATCH THE VIDEO Drake, Toosie Slide Drake's own Toronto mansion takes center stage in his video for Toosie Slide, and now we know why he kept singing just hold on, we're going home in one of his other hit songs - we'd rush home too if ours looked like this. WATCH THE VIDEO Jonas Brothers, Sucker If you're making a surprise comeback years after the breakup of your successful band of brothers, and you're not sure where to film your first music video, a 75,000-square-foot mansion that's over 400 years old should do the trick. The music video Sucker begins with an establishment image of the extraordinary exterior of Hatfield House, a Jacobean estate just outside London. We think it's safe to say that this house is the main attraction of this Jonas Brothers music video. We also want to parade around a historic English country house in a tulle ball gown with a pack of corgis, à la Queen Elizabeth II.WATCH THE VIDEO Bazzi, Myself You may have heard Bazzis singing Myself in various Tik Took videos in recent months, given that it has gone viral two years after being released, but we would much rather see the accompanying video for its highly showy French-inspired furniture (and the elegant poodles that sit on 7 furniture), baroque mirrors, and detailed casting. The boy is mine That's where it all started. Both Brandy and Monica were R&B it girls in the mid-90s, but when they got together for The Boy Is Mine, they were unstoppable. It was also their biggest point of contention, with the drama surrounding the song triggering their decades-long beef. It All Belongs To Me When Monica and Brandy temporarily crushed their beef in 2012, people thought it was the end of their years-long feud. It All Belongs To Me, Monica and Brandy have reunited and taken control of their narrative - at least temporarily. Fred Stobaugh, who had written an emotional letter commemorating his long-standing love, entered a video music competition. When they heard his story, the producers were so moved that they offered to have his lyrics recorded professionally, and the song became a viral iTunes hit.
